💸 Tax Season Reminders for Travel Healthcare Professionals

1. Know Your Tax Home (It's a Big Deal)

- If you're claiming tax-free stipends (like housing and meals), you need a legitimate tax home usually the place you permanently live when not on assignment.
- No tax home = those sweet tax-free perks could turn into taxable income. Ouch.
- 2. Track All Those Expenses
- Travel nurses and healthcare pros can often deduct:
 - Licensing & certification fees
 - Uniforms & work gear (yes, even the cute compression socks)
 - Continuing education
 - Travel between assignments (mileage, flights, etc.)
- 3. Understand Per Diem Pay vs. Hourly Pay
- Your stipends for meals & housing might not be taxed, but your regular hourly pay definitely is.
- Make sure you know how your pay breakdown works agencies often send confusing mixed pay stubs that can trip you up when filing.
- 4. Multi-State Tax Filing is the Name of the Game
- Worked in 3 states last year? Congrats, you probably get to file taxes in all 3.
- Each state has different rules for non-resident workers your tax software better be ready for the chaos.
- 5. Get a Pro (Seriously)
- Travel healthcare taxes are complicated, especially if you work in multiple states or have split taxable/tax-free income.
- A tax pro who specializes in travel healthcare can save you way more than they cost and spare you from IRS drama.


DANIELLE ARCHER
